

Supplementary Material – Video to Events: Recycling Video Datasets for Event Cameras

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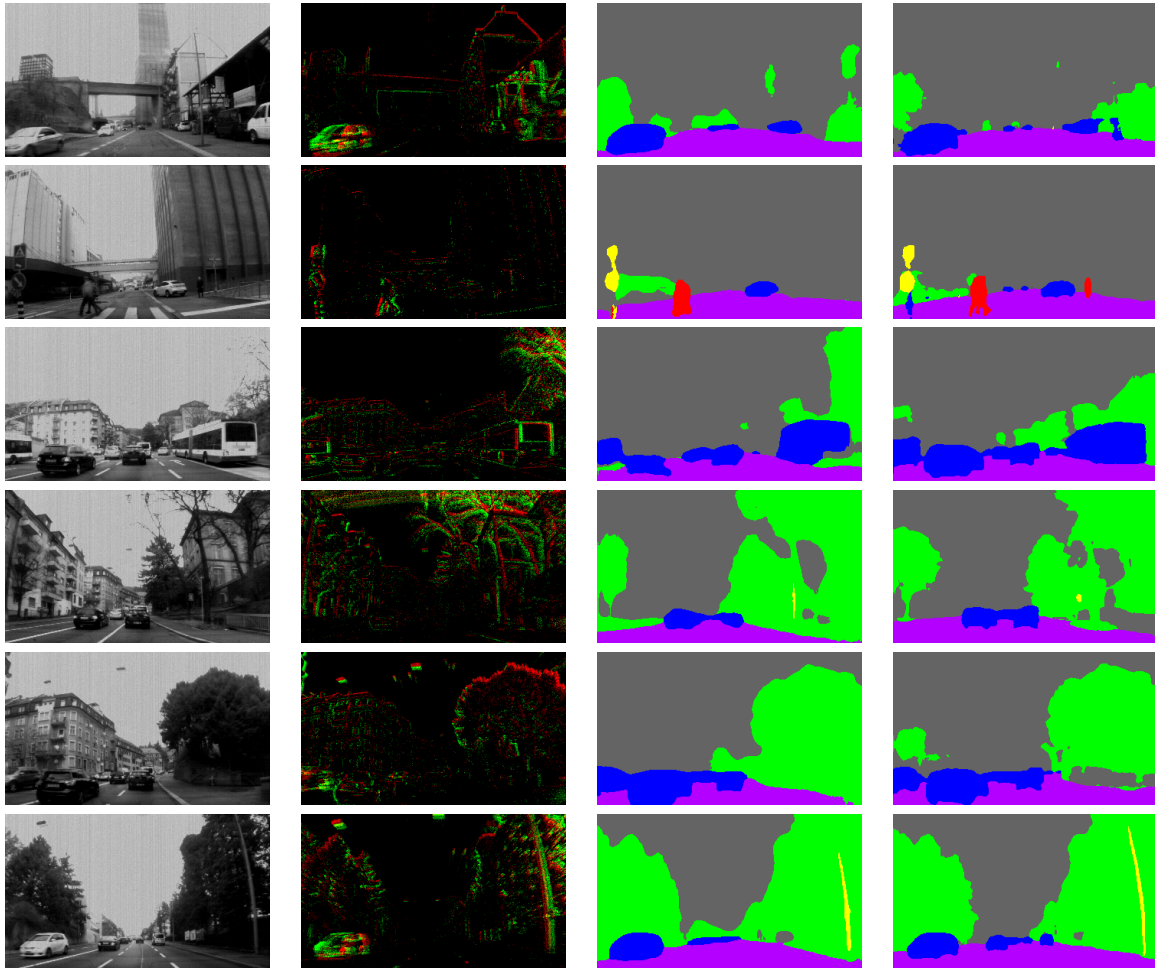
1. Appendix
